

Positioning as a Referee



- -Try to stick to your diagonal zone, to always have a proper view on your assistents!
- -Leave your diagonal zone if you think you need a better view on the situation (when the ball enters the penalty area for example.)

Signaling as a Referee



Using the whistle

Blow it <u>clearly</u>: be loud! All players should hear you.

<u>Do</u> blow your whistle to: give a free kick, allow a substitution or injury treatment

<u>Do</u> blow your whistle to restart play: with kick-offs, free kicks for which you place a wall, penalty kicks; or after a substitution/injury treatment <u>Do not</u> blow your whistle for: throw-ins, corner kicks, goal kicks, goals
